BASIC CRUISING

Day Skipper Sail

This course will teach you the basic skills and knowledge required to safely helm and crew on a sailboat of up to 10 metres in length, under sail or power, in moderate wind and sea conditions. The course offers a combination of theory and practical sessions to prepare you to sail confidently in familiar waters.

INTERMEDIATE CRUISING

Bareboat Skipper Sail

This course is for sailors who have their Basic Cruising Standard certification plus additional sailing time or have plenty of experience sailing in keelboats. The Intermediate Cruising live aboard course is highly recommended for people who are interested in chartering or owning a boat. It places an emphasis on practical training and skills required for extended cruising.

ADVANCED CRUISING

Coastal Skipper Sail

This course is intended for experienced sailors and navigators who want to be able to act safely as skipper and crew of a sailing cruiser of 8-15 metres, operating by day and night, in coastal or inland water in any weather. You need to have completed CYA Intermediate Cruising and Coastal Navigation, as well as First Aid and the VHF operator's certificate before taking this course.

Private Certification Courses - IYT



INTERNATIONAL BAREBOAT SKIPPER

This course covers Command of a vessel up to a maximum length of 78 ft. /24 metres In coastal waters up to 20 miles offshore and In daylight hours and in fair conditions with moderate wind and sea conditions. This certificate is the level of competence that one needs when chartering a boat in the Mediterranean or West Indies where there are restrictions in terms of cruising area and distance from the base and the vessel has to be safely moored in a marina or anchored before dark

International Bareboat Skipper

Option to obtain ICC by application (no further exams)

INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE (ICC)

This course leads to an ICC satisfying legal requirements for operators of vessels on most coastal waters of Europe and also (if required) CENVI for inland European waters.
