Day Skipper Sail

This course will teach you the basic skills and knowledge required to helm and crew on a sailboat of up to 10 metres in length, safely under sail or power, in moderate wind and sea conditions. The course offers a combination of theory and practical sessions to prepare you with the skills to sail confidently in familiar waters.

Format:

Basic and Intermediate are 6 days. You will sleep on the boat at anchorages and at another marina during the trip.

Basic Day Sailing Courses

Format:

INTERNATIONAL CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCE

This course leads to the award of an ICC satisfying legal requirements for operators of most vessels on coastal waters of Europe and also, optionally, CENVI for inland waters

It is given as a stand-alone weekend (2 day) course where it is recommended that you already have Intermediate Cruising as well as Coastal Navigation . Or the exam can be taken i(at extra cost) n conjunction with an intermediate course. **The practical portion is now included in the price of Intermediate**
